FERC Order 1000 Compliance

The focus of this strawman document are the additions and changes to the NCTPC Process that are necessitated by Order 1000 compliance requirements. The OSC reviewed and discussed various issues and potential solutions outlined in the strawman document related to the Order 1000 requirements.
