Subject: Next TAG Meeting

The next Transmission Advisory Group (TAG) meeting is tentatively scheduled for the afternoon of April 26th in Raleigh, NC. The purpose of this TAG meeting will be to: 1) review and discuss the NCTPC Supplemental Report on the 2006 Transmission Collaborative Plan which addresses the transmission upgrades necessary for a 1,200 MW transfer from Duke into Progress, 2) receive a status report on the 2007 Study activities, and 3) discuss the implications of the recent FERC Order 890 regional planning requirements on the NCTPC Process. The final draft of the 2006 Supplemental Report will be sent out to you for your review well in advance of this meeting. Your comments on the report will be solicited in advance of the meeting to ensure that any concerns or questions can be addressed at the scheduled meeting. The OSC and I look forward to your participation in the upcoming TAG meeting.
