At the September 17th TAG meeting, we discussed several potential NCTPC Process changes that were likely to be required as a result of FERC Order 890. It was agreed that the Participants would provide additional information to the TAG at this time and solicit feedback from the TAG on the proposed NCTPC Process changes. The following summarizes the additional information being provided as agreed at the September TAG meeting.

- 1. Clean and redlined versions of the NCTPC Process document (Attached) that provides changes to the Enhanced Transmission Access Planning (ETAP) Process section to now include the evaluation Regional Economic Transmission Paths (RETPs).
- 2. Clean and redlined versions of the TAG Scope document (Attached) that includes changes for the following:
 - a. Clarification and expansion of the TAG responsibilities.
 - b. New Membership definition specifying the qualifications for a valid stakeholder.
 - c. Updated voting protocol that aligns with the TAG responsibility for selecting the enhanced transmission access projects for evaluation.
 - d. Additional section added to address the new data and information distribution protocol that is required under the FERC Order.

In addition, we discussed the interest of TAG members to receive study information and results from other Inter-Regional planning-related activities at future TAG meetings. Please provide me your feedback on whether this information is something you would be interested in receiving at future TAG meeting.

The Participants are also interested in your additional feedback on both the Cost Allocation Methodology / Open Season Proposal and the proposed Inter Regional Participation Process that were presented and discussed at the September TAG meeting.

The amount of comments received will determine if we will schedule another TAG meeting to continue the discussion of these items. After the October 24th written comments deadline, I will let you know if we will proceed with one or both of the tentative TAG meeting dates.
